## **SAT/ACT Cancellations**



<u>The College Board has cancelled</u> the May 2nd SAT test date, and also stated that "Makeup exams for the March 14 administration (scheduled March 28) are also canceled. Registered students will receive refunds." This comes after the March 14, 2020 SAT administration was cancelled in locations that are heavily affected by the coronavirus.

The ACT has also postponed the April 4 test to June 13.

From the ACT: "ACT has rescheduled its April 4 national test date to June 13 across the U.S. in response to concerns about the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19). All students registered for the April 4 test date will receive an email from ACT in the next few days informing them of the postponement and instructions for free rescheduling to June 13 or a future national test date."

## **AP Exam Updates**

As for AP exams, students might be taking their exams at home this May, per the College Board.

They announced: "The AP program is finalizing streamlined AP exam options that would allow students to test at home, depending on the situation in May. We're working to give every AP student the opportunity to claim the credit they've earned. The AP Program will communicate the details of these additional solutions to educators and students by March 20."

## **IB Coursework and Exams**

IB has extended coursework deadlines for students affected by school closures due to COVID-19. IB is also encouraging students to contact their school's IB coordinator for more information.

- eCoursework early component deadline (15 March) extended to 12 April
- Internal assessment deadline (20 April) extended to **20 May**
- MYP personal project and ePortfolio deadline (20 April) extended to **20 May**
- CAS completion entry deadline (1 June) extended to 3 July
- Predicted grade entry for DP, CP and MYP is extended to 1 June
- Externally assessed components for film, dance, music, theatre and visual arts extended to **30 May**
- CP service learning and language development components to 1 June
- Language A: literature school-supported, self-taught alternative oral to 30 May
